MAXIMUM TIME

The maximum race time is set at 3 hours and 30 minutes, also to allow the gradual reopening of the roads to traffic. Two gates will be set up:

Km 10: for those who do not pass within 1 hour and 40 minutes;

Km 15: for those who do not pass within 2 hours and 30 minutes. All athletes (including Walkers) who pass after these times will be invited by the staff to stop.

TIMING - EVODATA TIMING - TIMING&DATA SOLUTIONS

The timing will be managed through a disposable transponder, special sensors will record the actual time taken by each athlete to complete the course, from the moment they cross the start line to when they cross the finish line. There will be carpets for chrono detection, also at km 5-10-15.

MEDICAL SERVICE

The medical service will be provided by the Italian Red Cross, which will provode ambulances, bike rescuers, a medical motorcycle, teams of rescuers, and finally 2 Advanced Medical Posts (PMA) at the finish line, complete with equipped setups, with doctors and related medical equipment.

AFTER THE FINISH LINE

At the end of the race, each athlete with a bib will receive a refreshment package containing:

- 1 Enervit Sport Drink Supplement
- 1 Eurospin single-portion Tarallini
- 1 Eurospin fruit juice
- 1 Eurospin Farciorange Snack
- 1 Eurospin banana
- 1 single-dose packet of Mielizia honey
- 10.5-liter bottle of Acqua Vera natural water
- 1 Apple

A GLUTEN-FREE REFRESHMENT is provided as every year.

The refreshment package will also include a waterproof PONCHO to wear for protection from cold and wind.

Later, you will receive the well-deserved medal!

Note: To facilitate a smooth flow of the many participants arriving at the finish line, once past the refreshment area, it will not be possible to go back.

RESULTS

Unofficial results will be available immediately after the finish on the website www.romaostia.it and on www.tdslive.com. The ranking will be drawn up in Real time. Both the CATEGORY rankings and those for obtaining sports equipment will be drawn up in Real time as well.

Three timing checkpoints are planned along the route, at km 5, 10, 15, to check passing times.

PHOTO SERVICE

Also this year, immediately after the race, you will receive your photos directly on your smartphone with full respect for privacy!

BAG COLLECTION

You will find the Bag Deposit trucks lined up after the refreshment area (i.e., after the area delimited by the high barriers), about 300 meters from the finish line. Position yourself in front of the right truck. Check the truck number on the bottom of your bib.

HOW TO RETURN TO THE START

Take the Rome-Lido train line at C. Colombo station (300 meters from the finish line) and get off at Eur Magliana (approximately 20 minutes).

From Eur Magliana, take the metro (Line B) to Eur Fermi station (2 stops, or get off at Ostiense, also on Line B of the metro).

For the return trip to Rome, we recommend that you have an ATAC ticket costing Euro 1.50, available at tobacco shops or from the automatic distributors at the stations.
